C. Brocious asked J. Ferrick if we're responsible for railroad signs. The sign on Mechanic St. needs to be fixed. L. Platz stated she received an email from a resident on N. Creek. Trees were cut and left on her property 5 years ago for the use of firewood but now she would like it cleaned up. After discussion the Supervisors said they would look into it farther.

J. Ferrick stated that the roadcrew was ready for the storm and that the new hire is working out very well.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Paul Pangratz questioned the safety of water if a small flow treatment system were installed on Ethel Drive near his property. Dion stated that Erie County Health Department regulates that and keeps records of water quality.

Dennis Olesnanik commented on the public meeting with PennDOT regarding the Beckman Rd. bridge. He said it was nice to see a positive turnout.

Jon Beckman, attorney for Cypress Creek, questioned what needs to be done in order to finalize the Solar Farm project.
