COMMENTS FROM THE SUPERVISORS

P. Dion stated that he was able to get 30 yards of mulch for the playgrounds at LECP through Millfair Recycling at no cost.

L. Platz shared that she and C. Brocious would be attending PSATS convention April 18th-22nd. She also discussed weed-spraying and that the township would be using a new company due to the rise in cost of the previous company.

COMMENTS FROM THE STAFF

Tiffany Kramer mentioned that the new sign at Lake Erie Community Park should be completed and installed in 2-3 weeks.

John Adams discussed current projects the road crew is working on and stated the tractor is back from being repaired.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Jeff Orr asked if the weed-spraying is something the township gets bids on. L. Platz said that due to the cost of the spraying, bidding is not necessary.

Kim Gilmore asked about Cross Station Rd. and if it would be paved. The Supervisors explained that it is not on the list of roads to be paved this year, but they are aware it needs work. Discussion was had regarding how we decide which roads to pave, water issues that need to be addressed and safety issues. Ray Penkalski asked for a specific date that the road would be dealt with, but it was explained to him unexpected expenses come up and it is not possible to give a specific date for paving.
