OLD BUSINESS – CivicPlus, the new website vendor, kickoff meeting took place on July 27th, full implementation will take a few months.

NEW BUSINESS

Motion by L. Platz, second by C. Brocious to approve distribution of Fire Tax monies collected from 05/23/26 to 07/24/26. Dobler, Lake City, and Platea Fire Departments will each receive \$5,723.36, motion carried (3-0).

COMMENTS FROM THE SUPERVISORS – C. Brocious mentioned Antolik Rd looks nice and has heard the same from neighbors. Also that Miller Rd patching came out good and the traffic is less now on that road since Antolik is finished. J. Adams said the road crew needs to get the shoulder back up done on Antolik and needs to replace the speed limit signs so they stand out more. They have about 900 feet of underdrains in on Cole Spring Rd. and are continuing to haul gravel. They dealt with a breakdown of the loader which is now fixed. L. Platz asked if there was any objection to donating the candy purchased for the Dan Rice Parade to the Fire Department to throw out at the parade as no one from the Township is available that day to drive a truck in the parade. Half of the candy will be donated for the parade and half saved for Halloween.

PUBLIC COMMENT- Bob Erdle asked if the Township ever had a speed limit sign on Smith St. from Nursery to the Borough line. C. Brocious replied that there has never been a sign on the Township portion of the road and a road study would need to be done in order to place one. Jeff Orr commented that everyone can go and see the bust of Dan Rice that will be on display at the Historic White House and Dan Rice will be getting married on Saturday morning during Dan Rice Days.
